POSITION PURPOSE

The Assistant Head of Electrics will provide assistance to the Head of Electrics in areas of planning, supervision, installation, strike, changeovers, and departmental maintenance, training, and other educational tasks.

POSITION FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assisting the Head of Electrics with the planning, supervision, installation, changeovers, and strike of the UFOMT productions including special projects undertaken by the UFOMT, space rentals, and theatre rentals.
- Research and development of new techniques, processes, and materials for the execution of lighting designs.
- Locating, ordering, and acquiring of materials and equipment needed for the electrics department.
- Hiring of over-hire labor and maintenance of the shop over-hire list.
- Operate console for productions and follow spots as assigned and/or required.
- Assisting and supervising load-ins, focuses, and note sessions.
- Maintaining the shop tools, equipment, and safety equipment in good working order, working independently on special projects as assigned by the Head of Electrics.
- Supervising and assisting in the evaluation of staff electricians, including assisting in education, training, and executing basic safety procedures.
- Perform such tasks, services, duties, and responsibilities in accordance with UFOMT policies, rules, regulations, and instructions now in force or which may be adopted from time to time during Employee's employment at the UFOMT.

OTHER FUNCTIONS

- Other duties as determined by the Head of Electrics and Director of Production.

- This position constantly communicates with colleagues via headset intercom systems.

- This position consistently positions self to assist with lighting system installs that includes, stooping, kneeling, or crouching.
- This position frequently ascends/descends stairs and ladders.
- This position consistently works on ladders and in elevated positions
- This position frequently ascends/descends ladders and personnel lifts.
- This position is often required to wear fall-arrest equipment
