The Electrician will perform duties assigned by the Head of Electrics/Assistant Head of Electrics in hanging, focusing, and programming equipment for all UFOMT productions. This position will also assist in maintaining shows, repair, and maintenance of equipment, and general clean-up.

## **POSITION FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Assist the Head of Electrics and Assistant Head of Electrics in hanging, focusing, and programming equipment for productions.
- Run and maintain shows, prepare for upcoming shows, maintain and repair equipment, and general clean-up as assigned.
- Assist in lighting in-house events and rentals as assigned.
- Operate follow spots for productions as assigned and/or required.
- Perform such tasks, services, duties, and responsibilities in accordance with UFOMT policies, rules, regulations, and instructions now in force or which may be adopted from time to time during Employee's employment at the UFOMT.

### **OTHER FUNCTIONS**

- Other duties as determined by the Head of Electrics and Director of Production.

- This position frequently ascends/descends ladders and personnel lifts.
- This position is often required to wear fall-arrest equipment
